## Introduction

The Israeli-Palestinian conflict stems from a dispute for land. The "Holy Land" is a piece of land that holds historical and religious significance to Christians, Jews and Muslims.<sup>1</sup> In 1947 the UN adopted the Partition Plan which aimed to divide the British Mandate of Palestine into Arab and Jewish states, this plan was never fully implemented by the UN; a year later Israel was created, and that sparked the first Israel-Arab War. 750,000 Palestinians were displaced as a result of the war and the territory was then divided into: The State of Israel, the West Bank and the Gaza Strip.<sup>2</sup> Following that in 1987 there was a mass uprising against the Israeli occupation in occupied Palestine, due to the Israeli's method of defence there was a major loss of life and mass injuries in the Palestinian population.<sup>3</sup> Today as the conflict continues, the UN and other humanitarian organisations have expressed deep frustration for Israel's refusal to leave Gaza. Death tolls in Gaza have risen to the point that many are "convinced that the Palestinian people are at grave risk of genocide".<sup>4</sup>

## Definition of Key Terms

**Two-state solution**: An independent state of Palestine as well as the State of Israel, west of the Jordan River.<sup>5</sup>

**Ceasefire**: An agreement that regulates the halting of all military activity for a certain amount of time in a given area.<sup>6</sup>

**Refugee**: Are persons who are forced out of their country of origin due to conflict, persecution or generalised violence and as a result need international protection.<sup>7</sup>

**Human shields**: A warfare method where the presence or movement of the civilian population is used to shield military objectives or military operations.<sup>8</sup>

**Genocide**: A crime or the act of killing with the intent to partially or fully destroy an ethnic, racial, religious or national group.<sup>9</sup>

## **Background Information**

In 1967 there was the Six Day War between Israel and a coalition of Arab states (Egypt, Syria and Jordan). This war lasted from 5 June to 10 June 1967 and resulted in more that 13000 casualties and 413000 Palestinians displaced.<sup>10</sup> On October 7 2023, Hamas sent multiple troops from Gaza along with RPGs and explosives to invade the south of Israel, while also firing numerous rockets towards Israel. This attack resulted in 1300 civilians murdered and 200 missing.<sup>11</sup> Since the early 2000's there have been many efforts to create peace in the area, with two-state solutions, demilitarisation of both Israel and Palestine as well the sharing of Jerusalem as both Israel's and Palestine's capital. Israel in its retaliation against Hamas has failed to minimise civilian casualties, resulting in at least 21,320 people being killed.<sup>1213</sup> The IDF has accused Hamas of using civilians as human shields by purposefully hiding behind Palestinian civilians in hospitals.<sup>14</sup> It is estimated that 1.4 million people are internally displaced within Gaza with 629,000 seeking refuge in UNRWA sites.<sup>15</sup>

## Major Countries and Organisations Involved

#### Israel

Under the current government of Benjamin Netanyahu, Israel aims to "*strengthen the status of Jerusalem*" which contradicts the many years of the aim to a two-state solution.<sup>16</sup> The Israel Defense Forces (IDF) have carried out multiple airstrikes on Gaza, with the "*clear goal of destroying Hamas's military and governing capabilities*".<sup>17</sup>

#### Palestine

Palestine came is divided into the West Bank, Gaza Strip. The Palestinian Authority (PA) has been in rule of the Palestinian state with attempts to sign with other parties in the past years.<sup>18</sup> According to the Gaza health Ministry, at least 21,000 people have been killed due to this conflict. Millions of Palestinians are displaced and thousands are seeking refuge; the state suffers from lack of fuel, electricity and clean water, due to IDF troops limiting the supplies that cross the Palestine-Israel border.<sup>19</sup>

#### Hamas

A Palestinian militant and Islamist group that operates in the West Bank and Gaza strip. It is dedicated to establishing Palestine as an independent Islamic state.<sup>20</sup> Founded in 1987 the group is best known for its armed resistance to Israel.<sup>21</sup>The group has run Gaza since 2007 and wants to destroy Israel so it can be replaced with an Islamic state.<sup>22</sup>

## United Nations Relief and Work Agency (UNRWA)

The largest UN organisation in the Gaza strip, its main goal is to provide emergency assistance to Palestine refugees in Gaza. It also specialises in human development services such as education and health.<sup>23</sup>

## United States of America

Since the 2021 Israel-Hamas conflict, the United States provided an additional \$1 billion in missile defence on top of \$4 billion it usually provides to Israel that already included \$500 million for missile defence.<sup>24</sup> The United States voted against ceasefire resolutions under the belief of the possibility of Hamas regrouping.<sup>25</sup>

## **Relevant UN Resolutions**

### A/RES/43/177

#### "Question of Palestine"

Focuses on achieving peace in the Middle East and its significant contribution to international peace and security. Guaranteeing freedom of access to Holy Places, religious buildings and sites.<sup>26</sup>

#### A/RES/ES-10/21

*"Protection of civilians and upholding legal and humanitarian obligations."* Reaffirming the obligation of nations to respect and uphold the international humanitarian law in all situations. Recalling Security Council resolutions on the protection of civilians in conflict, including children.<sup>27</sup>

#### S/RES/1397<sup>28</sup>

"Adopted by the Security Council at its 4489th meeting, on 12 march 2002"

Stresses the importance of respecting the international humanitarian law, and ensuring the safety of civilians. Demands the elimination of all acts of violence including terror, provocation, incitement and destruction.

## Previous Attempts to Solve the Issue

## Arab Peace Initiative (API)

A comprehensive peace plan proposed in 2002, that called for an end to the conflicts between Israel and Palestine, as well as fix the relations between Israel and the Arab world. This included that Israel withdrew from the areas it gained in the 1967 Six Day War.<sup>29</sup>

## The Geneva Initiative

A peace plan proposed after the Arab peace Initiative. It mainly focused on the recognition of Palestine and Israel as two separate states, a solution for the refugee problem, recognition of Jerusalem as an Israeli and Palestinian capital for the Jewish and Arab neighbourhoods, respectively and a demilitarised Palestinian state.<sup>30</sup>

### Israeli Peace Initiative (IPI)

A peace plan presented by the political left within Israel in response to the API. They accepted that the API was the framework for peace in the region and considered the IPI to be an Israeli contribution to the initiative. Within this there was emphasis on the coexistence of both Jew and Muslim groups, as well as Jerusalem being the capital of the two states of Israel and Palestine. It also considered a plan for refugees that they would gain financial compensation.<sup>31</sup>

## **Possible Solutions**

- 1. Creating violence free zones to ensure the safety of civilians, while permitting complete access to unlimited humanitarian aid and resources, that ensures the survival and well-being of civilians.
- 2. Building hospitals and residence areas in the violence free zones to support victims of conflict, while also having infrastructure such as schools and communication to create safer spaces for children and families..
